Manuscripts should be 12-point type, double-spaced, range in length from 4,000 to 6,000 words, and be fully footnoted and formatted according to the *Chicago Manual of Style* (17th edition). Junior faculty and advanced graduate students are encouraged to submit articles. All submissions undergo anonymous peer review and revisions may be requested.

The Lincoln Herald is published four times a year (Spring, Summer, Fall, and Winter).
