 County Wyoming and this shall  
 be your good and sufficient warrant  
 and you are required to return this  
 license to me within three months  
 from the celebration of such  
 marriage, with a certificate of the  
 same appended thereto, and signed  
 by you, under the penalty of Five  
 Hundred Dollars.
